Thoughts in Print - from Pastor Sue

How in the world is it December already?!?! And with the beginning of a New Year in our Church Calendar this last weekend, the Advent countdown to Christmas is in

full swing. One of my favorite devotional resources, d365.org, began the season with these words: "Hope is the assurance of God's faithfulness – period." In all the years since Jesus death and resurrection, this simple statement encapsulates much of what faith is all about. It reminds me of one of the most basic yet profound verses in all of scripture. Hebrews 11:1 - "Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen." As we once again live into this very special season, are we keeping it simple? Are we allowing space for the Spirit to fan the spark of faith into a flame to warm us not only in these cold winter months but when the coldness of life sometimes tries to take hold of us; to drag us away from our faith; from our hope. Bottom line, Advent comes each year to remind us of the fulfillment of God's promises to us embodied in the baby Jesus - period. Thank you each and everyone for your love, support and generosity to Holy Cross this past year! I want to keep you informed on some recent happenings at Holy Cross.

Pastor Sue and Sipe Adjustment Group have been dealing with our insurance company since the first week of the Parish Center (PC) fire. We are

heading for a finalization. Once we have accepted the offer, our Rebuilding Team will meet, will produce different scenarios on the PC and present them at a special congregation meeting.

We have been approved for a trailer on the great lawn. That also took a lot of work between the insurance company, Pastor, Sipe and the township. Look for the trailer in the next few weeks. We will use that for Sunday Church School, Confirmation class and meeting space.

Your Council has been hard at work getting our ministries up and running since Covid and the fire. Our hands had been tied due to Covid restrictions and the loss of the PC but there are many highlights:

Community Outreach, in conjunction with Christ Episcopal Church and Plentiful Plates, prepared and distributed 170+ dinners for Thanksgiving - several dinners went to the homeless.

Discipleship had a table at National Night out in Huddy Park in August, Hope Shed's Light BBQ and their annual walk in Seaside. The table has information on the church and our Nursery School, giveaways, and games for the youngsters.

Fellowship is hard at work coordinating the 60th Anniversary Dinner. They also sponsored a New Member Luncheon with another one planned for sometime in the Spring. Ideas for a bus trip and a BBQ and various other fellowship events are in the works.

Family Faith Formation started Sunday Church School in September, Confirmation began its 2 year program in October, First Holy Communion has always been active and will begin a new class in the Spring of 2023. Future youth activities are being planned and we are looking forward to the National Youth Gathering in New Orleans in 2024. In October there was a Halloween party for our Splash (ages 0 to 5) families with twenty-four attending.

Property is busy making repairs to the building inside and out.

Finance Team is almost done with a budget for 2024.

Executive Committee meets once a month.

Worship and Music Committee has new members, and there are new Worship Assistants, Ushers and Altar Guild members. They work extremely hard to make sure every thing is ready for Worship; the church is decorated for Advent, Christmas, and Easter. A decision was made to get rid of the choir robes and they are now gone. The closet is now being used for Altar Guild as their shed outside needs to be torn down. A huge Thank You to Jean Heidorn and Carol Capor for all their hard work with Anthems and Handbells.

The Council meets on the second Tuesday of each month, and anyone is welcome, but you must call me or Kenn Kerr (VP) to let us know you are coming and what you would like to discuss. We meet at the church except for our December meeting which is off-site.
