Dear Friends in Christ,

"Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I sent? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!" Isaiah 6:8

Everything in this life is a risk. You are given only two options. Take the risk and expect results or don't take the risk and expect nothing. What risks are you facing? Maybe a new job or a new house or even moving to another state.

But what about the risks God asked you to take on His behalf? God uses people who are willing to get out of their comfort zone. He uses people who are willing to take risks. Abram took a risk and become Abraham; Saul became Paul; the Leper approached Jesus for healing; Esther risked her life by approaching the king to save her people; Peter climbed out of the boat.

The first time I heard the hymn, "Here I am, Lord" and had to sing it was in 1996 during graduation from Diakonia. I still cry every time I sing it. I ask myself am I worthy to go out and do what God has asked me to do. Taking risks can be very frightening.

Here at Holy Cross we take a risk every summer, knowing that folks are away and that we receive no income from the Preschool during July and August, we risk our financial stability as our income is decreased during this time. This can also be frightening. We pray that the disciples here at HC will take a risk, to remember our financial needs year round through online giving, the Simply Giving program, by simply mailing in their offerings even when not physically present, or by considering an additional gift during this time of year.

God uses people who are willing to get out of their comfort zone. If God has told you to do take a risk, what are you waiting for, take the risk. "The Lord is the one who goes ahead of you; He will be with you; He will not fail you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed." *Deuteronomy 31:8.*

Pray on taking the risk knowing how much God loves you and that He goes ahead of you. That is when fear of taking the risk begins to diminish.
